Electronics are the fastest-growing waste stream globally with 20 to 50 million metric tons of e-waste being disposed of worldwide yearly. Only 12.5% of that e-waste is currently being recycled. When unwanted or broken electronics enter the waste stream into landfills, toxic substances like lead, cadmium, mercury, and other harmful components can create fumes we breathe in, leach into the soil, and seep into our groundwater (that we drink). Electronics also contain valuable non-renewable resources including gold, silver, copper, platinum, aluminum, and cobalt. This means that when we dispose of them without recycling, we throw away billions of dollars worth of precious materials. To help with this problem we are helping you reduce your e-waste by donating what can still be reused, recycling what is no longer working, and choosing a sustainable electronic practice in the future!
